Gold Circle Awards: Scholastic Recipients The Columbia Scholastic Press Association announces the winners from its 40th Gold Circle Awards program. This year, these categories attracted 4,051 entrants in yearbook and digital media.

These entries come from publications produced by students at colleges, universities, and secondary schools through the United States and overseas who follow an American education plan.

Entries were accepted from student yearbooks and digital media publications published from October 13, 2021 through October 10, 2022.

In summary, judges cited a total of 583 winners for yearbook and digital media for either First, Second or Third Place or for Certificates of Merit (honorable mention) in a category.

Entries for print news and print magazines that are published during the 2022-2023 academic year will be judged in fall 2023.
